Please note that on delivery the courier will require proof of identity and a signature to confirm receipt of the package.

Your client is advised not to make any travel arrangements until she has received her Biometric Residence Permit(s).

The Biometric Residence Permit is a residence permit which holds your client's biographic and biometric information and shows her immigration status and entitlements while they remain in the United Kingdom. The permit replaces the vignette (or sticker) and ink stamps previously placed in the passports of those granted permission to remain in the United Kingdom. A leaflet will accompany the permit which will give your client more information about it.

On receipt of the permit please ask your client to check it carefully to make sure all the details on it are correct. If she finds a mistake, she must e-mail BRPError@homeoffice.gsi.gov.uk within 10 working days of receiving the permit providing her full name, date of birth, nationality, case reference number, a contact telephone number and exact details of what is wrong with the BRP.
