Please find attached your Biometric Residence Permit. It is proof of your right to stay, work or study in the United Kingdom and may be used as a form of identification.

You may already have received a letter from the Home Office advising you that a decision on your application has been made and any supporting documents returned to you; if you have not yet received these, they should reach you shortly.

You must check the permit carefully to make sure that all the details on it are correct because you are required by law to have a card that accurately records your personal details and the type of permission you have to be in the United Kingdom.

If you find a mistake, please e-mail BRPError@homeoffice.gsi.gov.uk within 10 working days of getting the card, or you may be charged for a replacement and have to apply again. You should provide your full name, date of birth, nationality, passport number, contact telephone number, and your BRP and case reference number along with an explanation of what is wrong with the BRP.

The card has a unique number in the top right hand corner. The unique number for your card is shown at the top of this letter. You should keep this letter safe and in a separate place to your card as you will need this number to apply for a replacement card if yours is lost, stolen or damaged. You should also take a photocopy of the front and back of the card for your own records.

A leaflet is enclosed which provides further important information about the card. Please read it and keep it safe so you can refer to it again in the future.
